## Smart Light Multimode

#### Single Mode Models **NOT** Included

Mode 1 - FULL POWER green/white LEDs is the preferred mode.

Mode 2 - GREEN LEDs, when you want a darker green light field.

Mode 3 - WHITE LEDs, use out of water for emergency light & repairs. SEE WARNING.

Mode 4 - HALF POWER both color LEDs at half power for shallow use.


Mode 5 - HIGH SPEED STROBE to bust up bait/catfish blacking out lights.

Mode 6 - LOW SPEED STROBE set light deep. Targets rise to surface.

Mode 7 - HALF POWER STROBE (same as Mode 6) for deep/shallow use.

Mode 8 - S.O.S. SIGNAL [BETA] in testing & not included in all lights.



### Flotation Kit Assembly (Top Of Light):

- · Part (A) Float (3x3) (1).
- · Part (B) SS Chain (1).
- · Part (C) SS Split Rings (4).
- · Part (D) SS Washer (1).


#### **BOTTOM LIGHT ACCESSORIES**



#### **Bottom Light Accessories Installation:**

- · Thread the longline clip onto the split ring.
- · Grey bottom cap Thread longline split ring onto the metal hook.
- $\cdot$  Grey bottom cap Thread anchor rope into the longline split ring. Tie knot.
- · Green bottom cap Thread longline split ring to one of the hook holes.
- $\cdot$  Green bottom cap Add a 2nd empty split ring to the opposite hook hole.
- · Green bottom cap Thread anchor rope into the empty split ring. Tie knot.
- · Use cable ties (rated 75 lbs) to secure the short rope piece to the main rope.
- Wrap electrical tape to cover the cable ties to protect your hands.


#### **DEPRESS BUTTON TO CHANGE MODES**



## ⚠ ATTENTION!

### Setting Up The Light Anchor Rope Rigging

- · Leaded crab pot line is preferred. Cheap foam core rope floats.
- · Rope thickness should be 5/16" or 3/8". Recommend 17-20 feet.
- · Recommend attaching break away cable tie (75 lb.) to the anchor hook.
- $\cdot$  Tie the rope end to the cable tie (75 lbs.) attached to the anchor hook.
- · Secure the short rope tail to the main rope with cable ties.
- $\cdot$  Use electrical tape to cover the cable ties to prevent injury to hands.
- · Bring spare anchors. Every light deployment risks losing the anchor.



### **Light Anchor Weight Specifications:**

- · Your anchor choice should be between 7-10 lbs. maximum.
- · Round or mushroom type shape anchors slide & roll in current.
- · Handheld square type weights & pyramid shapes are good.
- · Be creative! The goal is to get the anchor to hold without sliding.
- $\cdot$  Custom pour several types of anchors using concrete & U bolts.
- · Cheap red clay pots & plastic containers make good molds.
- · Bring spare light anchors. Every light deployment risks losing the anchor.

- · 2-year warranty for the lamp and cord. 90-day warranty on accessories.
- · Warranty claims require proof of purchase or a warranty registration.
- Warranty will be voided for misuse, neglect, or unauthorized repairs.
- · Warranty will be voided from damages resulting from excessive force.
- · Warranty will be voided for power surges & DC volts > 12v.

## T PRODUCT SAFETY WARNING

The metal frame gets hot out of the water and can cause injury to your hands. Keep the light submerged when powered to prevent injury while using the other modes. If you have a sensitivity to flashing lights do not stare at the smart light when using modes (5-8). Cords laying on the deck can cause accidents. Deploy as much of the cord as possible into the water. Keep children and pets away from a powered light out of the water.

- · Mode 3 [PRO] CAN be used out of the water as a light source.
- · Mode 3 [ULTRA] CANNOT be used out of the water in any mode.

#### **Light Maintenance**

- · Rinse the light after every use to include the battery clips.
- Inspect the light and light cord for damage.
- · Keep the light from being exposed to daylight indoors/outdoors.
- · UV light will prematurely yellow the glue, store the lamp in the zipper bag.
- · Use electrical grease to coat the spring inside the alligator clips.
- $\cdot$  When replacing battery connectors, solder all exposed copper wire.
- · **DO NOT** use liquid tape to cover exposed wire. This will fail the light.
- · DO NOT place cable ties direct to cord. Place on electrical tape or tubing.
- · **DO NOT** store lights in hot cars or compartments.
